Communications & Digital

Communications and Digital interns will assist the Communications and Digital Director with conducting research, monitoring media activity, producing content for social media posts and emails, and website management.

Data

Data interns will work directly with the NDP's Data Director learning skills in areas including VAN administration and voter targeting. Interns will develop skills through development and application of relevant skills that can be applied to a wide variety of workplaces in addition to political, non-profit, and advocacy organizations.

Legislative Campaign

Legislative Campaign interns will assist the Party staff in aiding legislative races during this important election cycle. Interns will help with recruiting and organizing volunteers for several legislative campaign races as well as draft content for mail pieces, emails, and scripts. Interns must be detail oriented, organized, hard working, and have a basic understanding of Microsoft Word and Excel.

Outreach & Party Building

Interns can expect to assist with organizing volunteers to help elect Democrats up and down the ticket across Nebraska. Interns will work with the NDP Outreach Director to maintain party services with local party organizations, elected officials, and campaigns. Intern activities create a well-rounded experience that will include administrative duties, networking, research and more.

Research
